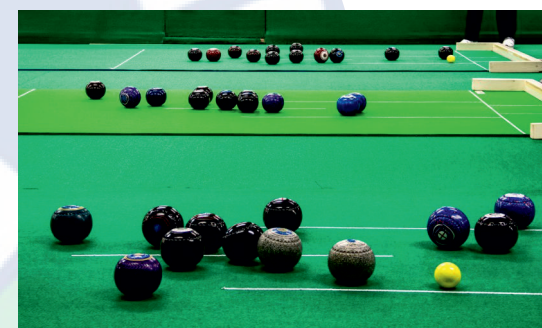

## Fancy giving it a go?

Short Mat Bowls is a sport for all - any age, any ability - and we play all year round. Short Mat Bowls was derived from Outdoor Lawn Bowls and has been actively played in England since the 1960s.



Short Mat Bowls is played on a special 45ft x 6ft Carpet which has specific markings only relevant to

Short Mat Bowls. The Sport is often found in Village Halls, Community Centres, Indoor Bowls Halls and Outdoor Bowling Club Pavilions.

Although it's a more condensed version of Outdoor Bowls it's no lesser of a sport, in fact it requires a great deal of skill.

Short Mat Bowls can be played at all levels; from simply having a friendly roll-up at your local club to playing on the International Circuit and representing England at the British Isles Championships or the World Championships.

### COACHING

Here in England the 4 Principal Bowls Governing Bodies subscribe to a Nationally recognised Coaching Program: CoachBowls.

This means all of our Coaches are trained to a specific standard to coach both new and existing Players of all abilities.

### EQUIPMENT

Short Mat Bowls is played on a specialist 45ft x 6ft Carpet playing surface which is able to be rolled up and easily stored or transported. They come in a variety of speeds and different surface colours. In the middle of the Carpet is an obstacle called the block to prevent bowls from being played straight up the middle.



We use the same Bowls as both Lawn and Indoor Bowls which are available in different sizes and bias (Bias makes the Bowls turn). Most Bowls Manufacturers now offer the ability to customise the colour and engraving of the bowls.

### INCLUSIVITY

Not all Children want or are able to play the traditional school sports of Football, Rugby, Hockey, Netball and Cricket, however Bowls is a game that is accessible to all abilities. Short Mat Bowls can be played in School Halls, Sports Centres and even classrooms.

In England we have an Under 21 Academy, allowing under 21s of all abilities to receive coaching and being able to represent England at youth level.
