This Month's Focus – Safe Club Membership

It is important that we safeguard all of our members and this should begin when an individual applies to be a member of a club. You may wish to consider including the below into your membership application form if you don't already do so. It's good practice to review your membership data base annually to ensure all the information held on members is still current in case of any emergencies.

- Full name
- Date of Birth
- Address
- Home / mobile telephone number
- Email address
- Next of kin name and contact details
- Medical history – this is important for safety and wellbeing.
- Self-Disclosure – it is important to establish if a membership could have a negative impact on a club and if any risk assessments / supportive measures need to be taken. Please contact your NGB if you require further support with this.
- Reference – it may be useful to include a reference to endorse the membership.
- Signature of the applicant.
- Date form completed.
- Privacy statement.
- Check ID but do not keep a copy – is this person really who they say they are?
